Sustainability Victoria is an Agency that is aiming to lead Victorians to a 60% drop in greenhouse pollution by 2050 and to reduce household emissions by 10% by 2010. Australia remains the highest producer of greenhouse pollution per capita in the world, we produce more than 2000 kg of waste per person per year and, despite an ongoing drought, we consume more water in households than any other nation. Sustainability Victoria developed the Resource Smart program for solutions on climate change for households, businesses, governments and communities.

They have recently been appointing ResourceSmart Ambassadors to help promote their messages and Kate and Millicent were delighted to have been asked to become Ambassadors for Sustainability Victoria. Their first task is to be Smart Resource Ambassadors whilst at the Children's conference on Climate change in Surabaya and on their return they will widely present the findings from this Conference.
